Welcome to our 2009/2010 catalogue. We look forward to another successful year at the nursery. Everyone at the nursery takes pride in providing the friendly, helpful and efficient service enjoyed by our customers.

We have tried to include all of our stock in the catalogue but are continually adding new stock and varieties so please do enquire if a requirement is not listed. We may have it or be able to obtain it for you.

The field-grown trees, hedging and forestry plants are available throughout the dormant season, from approximately early November to April. These are sold bareroot, or with a rootball. We also keep a comprehensive stock of trees and shrubs in containers for year round planting.

We are committed to providing an environmentally friendly product and only use peat-free compost for our container grown plants. We try to ensure that any plants obtained from other sources are grown in peat-free compost. We also use some compost from recycled waste.

For broadleaf trees, conifers and hedging plants we continue to use a table of prices based on codes. We do not have every tree in every size! – Please enquire for availability. If we have to obtain plants for an order it may not be possible to price according to the table. The prices quoted for shrubs are based on plants in 3 litre pots. We also have many in 2 litre pots and some larger specimens – again, please enquire for availability. Discounts may be available for customers buying in large quantities. We have a good selection of big trees, some of which we can offer at discounted prices.

We provide a delivery and/or planting service with our own transport to anywhere in the UK. Unfortunately costs can be high but we will always keep these to a minimum by combining deliveries to a particular area.

We can send smaller orders, depending on the size of the plants, by national carrier with next day delivery. Also, of course, customers can collect from the nursery. We can load even the biggest trees.

Customers are always welcome to visit us and seek advice on planting schemes. Please phone in advance so that we can ensure that we have someone available to show you around. There is also a small arboretum adjacent to the nursery which customers are welcome to visit.

The nursery opening hours are 0730-1630 Monday to Friday (not Bank Holidays).

We look forward to meeting new customers and welcoming back those who have been with us for many years.

Containerised plants are listed as 'pot' or 'CG' (container grown).

Field-grown trees are sold as b/r (bareroot) or r/b (rootballed).
